
AN INSPIRING, WELCOMING VENUE FOR LEARNING ABOUT



The purpose of the Vista Alegre Museum is to promote access to Vista Alegre's industrial heritage and collections, together with their interpretation.

In this brochure, we will explain the tour schedules we offer to different school grade levels and age groups. There are guided

tours for exploring the local landscape and history, and visits to the museum to learn about the world of decorative arts and industrial heritage. We also offer workshop tours, which focus on interacting with materials to encourage creativity and experimentation.





A guided tour of the Vista Alegre Museum promises a journey through the world of decorative arts and industrial ceramics. This option includes a visit to the factory's Hand-Painting Workshop and to the Our Lady of Penha de França Chapel, dating from the late 17th century, classified as a national monument.

Admission (1 teacher allowed for every 10 students):

Groups of 10-20 students: €4.20/student Groups of 21-30 students: €4.05/student Groups of 31 or more students: €3.90/student



This option includes a guided tour of the Our Lady of Penha de França Chapel, a national monument dating from the late 17th century, and an introduction at the museum's reception area. The rest of the museum visit is open in nature, and includes entry to the factory's Hand-Painting Workshop.





PORCELAIN, HOW I ADORE YOU!

A guided tour of the museum to learn about the history of porcelain. By observing objects and handling materials, we examine porcelain's different sizes, shapes, colours and uses

MAGIC SAFARI

Did you know that the genet, the grass snake, the Iberian wolf, the wildcat and the fox are Portuguese fauna classified as endangered species? Come learn more about them and give them new colours, by decorating a porcelain plate with acrylic paints.

Non-guided tour of the museum, including a worksheet and acrylic painting workshop.

What does porcelain look like? What is its colour, smell and sound? As potters for one day, we will hold moulds, modelling tools and sponges to learn more about this material.

Guided tour of the museum and porcelain-modelling workshop.

Non-guided tour of the museum through a worksheet to look at Vista Alegre pieces and discover decorative features from different historical time periods. Inspired by porcelain, students are invited to decorate a plate and adorn it with acrylic paints at the Painting Workshop.

The start of the 19th century in Portugal was a dynamic period marked by the Liberal Revolution and Industrial Revolution. Let us go back to 1824, the year that the Vista Alegre Factory was founded, to understand its importance in the context of that time.

### VISTA ALEGRE, ART OF PAINTING



Guided tour of the Vista Alegre Museum, including the factory's Hand-Painting Workshop, together with a workshop with ceramic paints. An initiation to the art of ceramic decoration, which teaches the basic skills of painting with a brush, supervised by specialised Vista Alegre painters.
